Course Description

Increases the variety and depth of the student's interest, knowledge, and involvement in music and related cultural activities. Acquaints the student with traditional and twentieth century music literature, emphasizing the relationship music has as an art form with man and society. Increases the student's awareness of the composers and performers of all eras through listening and concert experiences. Part II of II

The student will explore various time periods and cultures, along with historical and societal references through instrumental and vocal music. The students will be introduced to a variety of musical compositions, forms, instruments, and composers of each historical era. The student will learn to identify musical works and instruments through listening experiences, while becoming acquainted with basic musical terminology. Music 122 covers the nineteenth and 20th centuries.
