COURSE OUTLINE

Prerequisites: None

Course Description:

Introduces understanding, speaking, reading, and writing skills and emphasizes basic German sentence structures.

Students learn to function in the language within a limited context of vocabulary and structures. The course includes a general introduction to culture.

In this course, the student will review and continue the study of grammar while refining the skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The textbook will constitute the basis of the work, with additional material to which supplement the topics studying.
