- Utilize critical reasoning, role modeling, and creativity to meet the needs of children with diverse psychosocial, physical, and cultural backgrounds in a variety of settings.
- 5. Assume responsibility for expansion of knowledge base in the area of child health nursing.
- 6. Evaluate possible legal/ethical issues in the area of child nursing.
- 7. Understand cultural/social/economical and political influence that can impact the health and care provided to children.
