# Virginia Western Community College HLT 100 First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

## **Prerequisites**

## **Course Description**

Focuses on the principles and techniques of safety, first aid, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation. This course presents students with knowledge and skills necessary to help sustain life and minimize the consequence of injury or sudden illness until advanced help arrives. Topics include emergency and hazardous condition recognition as well as adult, child and infant CPR / AED and first aid. Students will have the opportunity to obtain a Red Cross certification upon successful completion of written and practical exams.
